










## Best CBB Strategies



- 1. Strip and destroy all remaining cherry
- 2. Prune
- 3. Trap
- 4. Spray B. bassiana early and often
- 5. Continue to spray throughout season
- 6. Harvest often
- 7. Avoid dropping cherry
