CUPPING COMPETITION OVERVIEW

The 2022 HCA Cupping Competition received 95 entries from growing regions across the Hawaiian Islands. Each farm business was limited to a maximum of three entries with differentiation of variety, cultivation, or processing method for each coffee. Throughout the week of the cupping competition, coffees were roasted in one-pound batches and assigned a random identification code known only to the competition roaster, Brittany Horn.

From May 10th to 12th, Licensed Q Arabica Graders gathered at Pacific Coffee Research's Cupping Lab to evaluate and score samples. The competition entries were scored using the SCA's globallyrecognized cupping protocol which includes rankings on the basis of fragrance/aroma, flavor, aftertaste, acidity, body, uniformity, balance, clean cup, sweetness, overall, and defect count. Scores and descriptors were recorded using Cropster Cup quality analysis software and will be shared via detailed reports to all entrants after the announcement of the final scores on May 20th, 2022.

Scores are published for coffees that received a specialty rating at 80 points or above. The Hawai'i Coffee Association will issue awards to the top ten in the State, and the top scoring coffees from each growing region.

A plant breeder by training, Long brings over 25 years of experience in international agricultural research partnerships to the coffee research community. Before taking the helm at WCR in 2019, Long led the Office of Agricultural Research & Policy at the US Agency for International Development and previously served as a science policy fellow at USDA's Foreign Agricultural Service working on phytosanitary and sanitary trade barriers in plants and plant products. She received her PhD in plant breeding from Cornell University.
