How do I choose the right package?

When you ship items using **FedEx One Rate**, you have a variety of packaging options. It's important to select the right packaging type to ensure your contents are properly protected during transit and avoid increases to the price of shipping.

FedEx One Rate packages are rated based on package volume, which is measured in cubic inches (length x width x height) using the exterior package dimensions. To select the right packaging type for your items, we recommend that you follow these guidelines.

- Contents must fit into selected packaging; do not force contents to fit.
- FedEx Express packaging must close using built-in adhesive strip.
- Use of additional tape to ensure package closure may indicate volume limit is exceeded.

FedEx One Rate Envelopes have been tested and recommended for items measuring no more than 2 inches along its shortest side. Any FedEx One Rate Envelope measuring more than two inches along its shortest side, or any FedEx One Rate Pak measuring more than five inches along its shortest side (as determined by FedEx) may be re-rated as a One Rate box based on the package's overall cubic volume.*

How do I measure volume for irregularly shaped packages?

To determine the volume of irregularly shaped packages, measure these dimensions in inches:		If measurement value is:	
Length	Longest dimension	0"–.49"	Round down to the nearest inch
Width	Second-longest dimension	.50"–.99	Round up to the nearest inch
Height	Shortest dimension

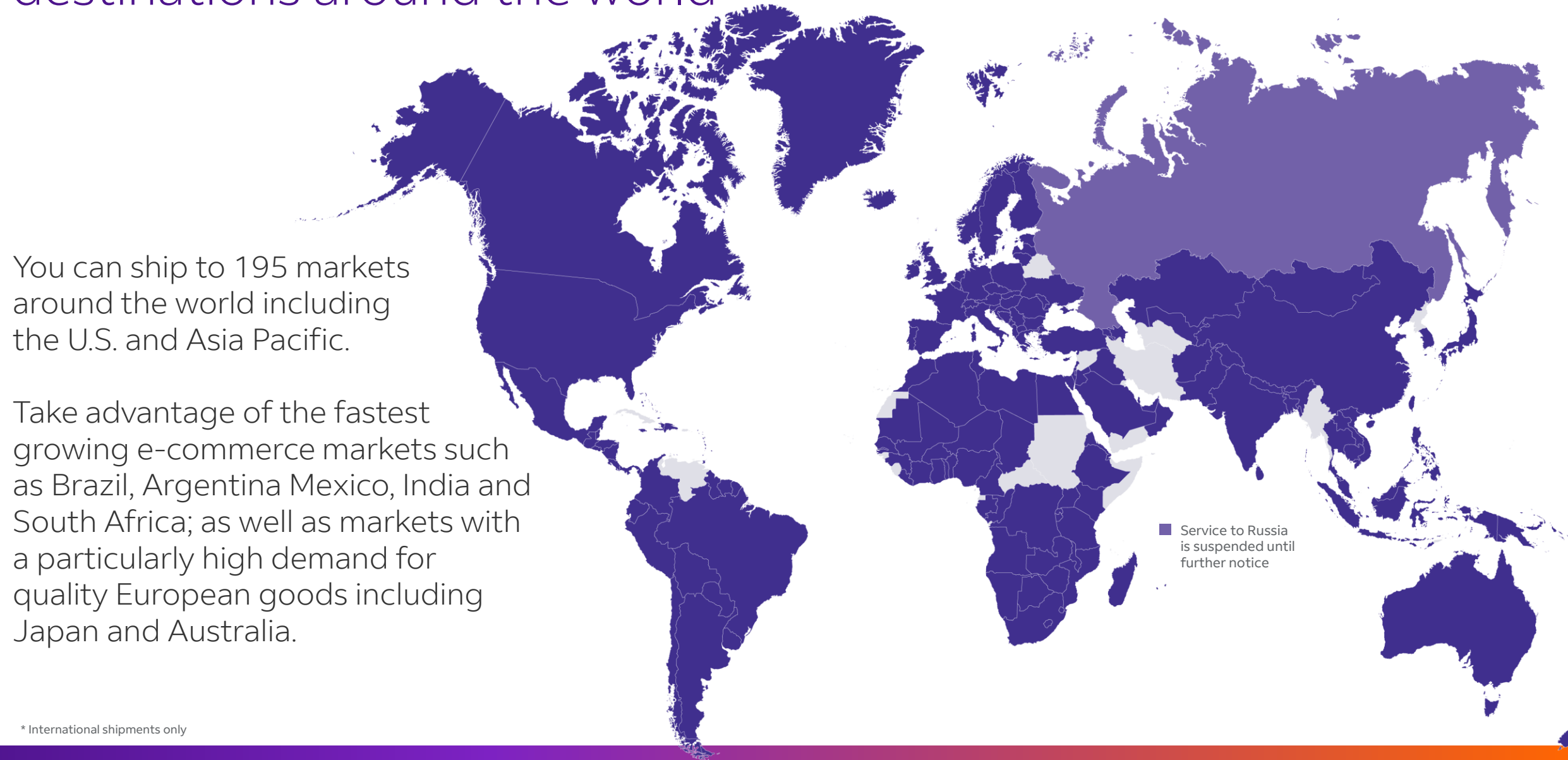
