Priaxor® Xemium brand fungicide is a translaminar (localized leaf systemic) fungicide that is being sought by the Hawaii Coffee Growers Association for approval of use on coffee in Hawaii under a Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) Section 18 Emergency Exemption. If approved and used properly, Priaxor has the ability to kill coffee leaf rust (CLR) within coffee plant leaves, unlike currently approved contact fungicides that kill CLR spores on the outside of the leaf.
